II. John 14:17 “...YOU KNOW HIM”

A.W. Tozer - *“In most Christian churches the Holy Spirit is entirely overlooked, whether He is present or absent makes no real difference to anyone.”*

Most all Christians have heard ABOUT the Holy Spirit. But, do you KNOW HIM? As a real divine person who can be KNOWN and LOVED and WORSHIPPED in an intimate relationship.

The word “know” here means knowledge that comes from experience, not just the intellect (what you know).

It is one thing to know about someone, but quite another to know them personally.

B. WORD PICTURES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

It is often difficult to impart truth by the use of words only. Emblems or picture-types help unfold a greater understanding.

1. FIRE: Speaks of His consuming, purifying power in the life of the believer. Luke 3:16 Acts 2:3 Isaiah 6:1-7
2. WIND: Speaks of His unseen gentleness to blow a leaf, or to blow down a tree. John 3:8 “Mighty rushing wind” Acts 2:2
3. WATER: Speaks of His washing / cleansing power to fill the believer to overflowing with spiritual life. 1 Corinthians 6:11 Titus 3:5 John 7:37-39

- 4. A SEAL: Speaks of His ownership of the believer. It is a finished, eternal transaction. Ephesians 1:13
- 5. OIL: Speaks of His power to anoint for service and/or healing. Acts 10:38 Mark 6:13
- 6. DOVE: Speaks of His gentle, tender, peaceful nature. Luke 3:22

A. Glorify Jesus ⇒ TO YOU:

A More Intimate relationship with Jesus requires a more intimate relationship with the Holy Spirit. He Reveals Jesus.

2 John 17:24 “with Me that they may behold My glory”

3 2 Corinthians 13:14 Therefore we MUST FELLOWSHIP WITH
the HOLY SPIRIT.

4 2 Corinthians 3:18 As we look at what the Holy Spirit reveals of
the Glory of the Lord - HE CHANGES US.

- h) **GENTLENESS / MEEKNESS** **Love's Humility.** 2 Corinthians 10:1
 Matthew 11:28-29 5:5
- g) **SELF-CONTROL** **Love's Victory** 1 Corinthians 9:24-27
