# II. HOW TO PRAY Matthew 6:5-13

- Vs. 5 Not to pray to impress others: Long Loud Change Voice.
- Vs. 6 Have a quiet place.
- Vs. 7 Meaningless repetition.
- Vs. 9 Pray to "Our Father." Or To Jesus: Acts 7:59 Romans 10:13

Also told to pray in the name of Jesus. John 14:13-14

Depend on the guidance of the Holy Spirit Romans 8:26-27

We are to pray for His Name to be treated as HOLY.

This includes Praise & Worship

Deuteronomy 28:58 1 Samuel 17:45-47 1 Kings 8:41-43

Psalm 99:3; 111:9 Luke 1:49

Vs. 10 We are to pray for the coming of His Kingdom.

In my life / my family / my church / my city / my nation

We are to pray for His will to be done in everything.

- Vs. 11 We are to pray for our daily necessities.
- Vs. 12 We are to pray for forgiveness and practice forgiving everyone. Even my enemies. We should be a source of grace and give grace to

everyone. This is done by: 1. "taking up our cross"

2. Praying: "Father forgive them . . . "

Vs. 13 We are to pray for the leading of the Lord and deliverance from evil. In areas of our weakness.

Kneeling three times a day: Daniel 6:10 Psalm 55:17; 95:6

• Stand and pray: Mark 11:25

Sometimes barefoot: Acts 7:33

All the time: Ephesians 6:18 Sometimes in the second of the seco

# III. Mighty Prevailing Prayer. Thy Kingdom Come!

### A. WHY PRAY?

- 1. **DOMINION** of the earth given to man.
  - a. Genesis 1: 28
  - b. Psalm 115:16
  - c. Psalm 8:4-8 and Hebrews 2:5-8
  - d. Revelation 5:10
- 2. Keys of **AUTHORITY** Given To Man: Matthew 16:19
  - a. Adam gave his authority to satan. Jesus took it back.
  - b. Keys:
    - Authority & Responsibility
    - Open gates & close gates
  - c. In giving us the keys, the Lord has limited certain of His activities to the prayers of His people.

# OFTEN, IF WE DO NOT PRAY, HE WILL DO NOTHING.

3. Heaven Wills Then WAITS . . . For Man To Become:

ANGRY ENOUGH / SICK ENOUGH / TIRED ENOUGH TO PRAY!! TO CRY OUT TO GOD: THY KINGDOM COME, THY WILL BE DONE.

- 1. In Covenant with Jesus we have LEGAL RIGHTS.
